ABOUT THE PROJECT

A major consequence of the COVID19 pandemic on Nigerians is hunger due to the inability to go out and work as a result of the lock down and self isolation. #FeedIbadan is a project organized by Act Hub Africa and Food and Genes Initiative in collaboration with One Voice Initiative and other organizations in Ibadan, Oyo State, Nigeria to provide palliatives for less privileged people. The funds for the project came in through crowdfunding using social media platforms, friends and collaboration with other organizations.

This report is for the first phase of the Project which was carried out in Aromalaran and Agugu Community in Ibadan North east local government, Ibadan, Oyo State, Nigeria.

WHERE

The project (#FeedIbadan) was carried out at 2 different location of Ibadan North East Local Government, Ibadan, Oyo state, Nigeria.

WHY

The idea was birthed out of concern for the hardship people are facing during this COVID-19 pandemic lock-down order as put in place by Oyo state government to help the state in containing the pandemic. The project is a response to palliative call by citizens of Oyo state who are in one way or the other, their means of livelihood has been negatively affected.
